3) APPEAL INSTRUCTIONS

An appeal period opens as from 29th June 2022, until 4th July 2022 (12.00 CET). Those candidates wishing to apply for a reconsideration of the selection process must send an e-mail to planthealth@upv.es until the date and hour indicated above.

Reasons to appeal must be duly justified. Before appealing, please read carefully the information contained in the section "Application procedure" (https://www.planthealth.upv.es/web/apply/application-procedure/) regarding admission criteria and application procedure. Late, incomplete or incorrect applications are not reasons for appeal.

NOTE 1: This selection process corresponds to the Master Intake $7 - 2^{nd}$ call (self-funded candidates). The selection applies exclusively to the call and intake for which the candidates have been selected and shall not compromise future selection processes.

NOTE 2: Participating on a self-funding basis means that candidates have sufficient funds to cover the whole two years period (participation costs, trip from home country to the host universities, accommodation and daily allowance), either with their own resources or with the support of a scholarship from another scheme.
