#### PARTICIPATION AS SELF-FUNDED STUDENT

- Self-funded candidates are students with sufficient funds (or external funding) to cover the derived costs of attending the 2-year Master's programme in Europe, such as:
  - Master's Participation Costs (https://www.planthealth.upv.es/web/apply/participation-fees/)
  - Travel costs: Students will have to cover the costs of different trips according to their mobility scheme:
    - > T1: From home country to Valencia (Spain), where the Orientation Week takes place
    - > T2: from Valencia (Spain) to the M1 university (if different from UPV)
    - > T3: from the M1 university to the M2 university
    - > T4: from the M2 university to Valencia (Spain), where the Final Conference will take place.
    - > T5: from Valencia to home country
  - Living costs: around 500 EUR per month, depending on host city





### **APPEAL PROCEDURE**

- Candidates who have followed the application procedure and respected the submission deadline, but who have been refused admission, have the right to appeal against the Selection Board's decision
- Candidates who had not submitted the required documents by the application deadline will not be able to appeal against the results
- Before appealing against the results, candidates should carefully read the eligibility requirements, selection criteria and application procedure at:

- The appeal procedure will solely focus on the evaluation made for compliance with the established eligibility requirements. New information, clarifications or documents that should have been included in the proposal will not be taken into account
- If you have reason to believe that an error has been made about your application, please send an email to <a href="mailto:planthealth@upv.es">planthealth@upv.es</a> exposing your allegations within the deadline for appeal. We will evaluate each case individually and notify the appellants as soon as possible
- The appeal period for the results of the Intake 8 general selection is opened from 20<sup>th</sup> until 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023 (12.00 CET)
